

ADDRESSING TOBACCO USE WITHIN BEHAVIORAL HEALTH SETTINGS IN HAWAI'I

SAMHSA (Substance Abuse and Mental Health Services Administration) has developed an online search engine (the Behavioral Health Treatment Services Locator) that allows the public to find mental health and/or substance use treatment facilities in any U.S. city, county, state or U.S. Territory along with what smoking cessation services they provide and whether they have a smoke-free campus policy among other services and practices.



All information in the Locator (<https://findtreatment.samhsa.gov/>) is updated annually from facility responses to SAMHSA's National Survey of Substance Abuse Treatment Services (N-SSATS) and the National Mental Health Services Survey (N-MHSS). New facilities that have completed an abbreviated survey and met all the qualifications are added monthly. All information obtained in this document are only from facilities that responded to the N-SSATS and N-MHSS surveys. As such, these numbers may not reflect ALL behavioral health treatment facilities in Hawai'i.

Hawai'i is interested in examining tobacco related policy, screening, and treatment facilities within behavioral health settings.

To assess tobacco treatment and behavioral health in Hawai'i, the Locator* was used to determine if any of the following services below are provided in mental health or substance use treatment facilities in Hawai'i:

1. Screening for tobacco use
2. Smoking/tobacco cessation counseling
3. Non-nicotine smoking/tobacco cessation medications
4. Nicotine replacement therapy
5. Smoking not permitted
6. Smoking permitted in designated area
7. Smoking permitted without restriction

HAWAI'I HAS 180 IDENTIFIED BEHAVIORAL HEALTH TREATMENT FACILITIES

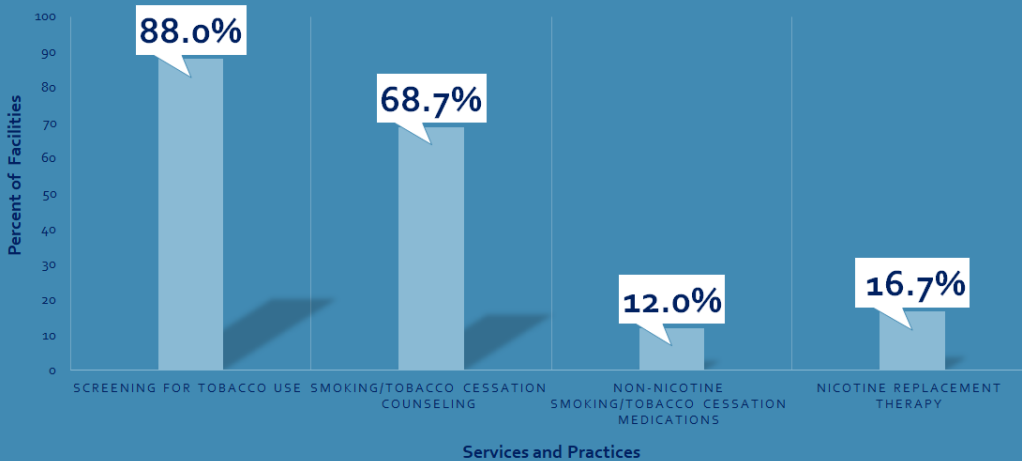
SUBSTANCE USE POLICY, SCREENING AND TREATMENT FACILITIES IN HAWAII

Of the 180 behavioral health treatment facilities in Hawai'i, **150 (83.3%)** are **substance use treatment** facilities.



Substance use treatment facilities are those with licensure/accreditation/approval to provide substance use treatment.

WHICH OF THESE SERVICES AND PRACTICES ARE OFFERED AT SUBSTANCE USE TREATMENT FACILITIES (N=150)?



Less than a quarter of substance use treatment facilities offer nicotine replacement therapy (16.7%) and non-nicotine smoking/tobacco cessation medications (12.0%).

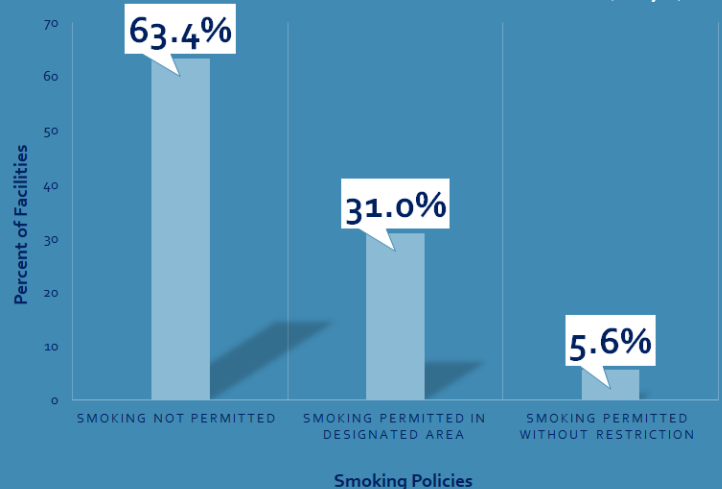
Most substance use treatment facilities offer tobacco use screening (88.0%).

Note: Percentages related to services and practices offered at Substance Use treatment facilities will not total 100% as each facility may offer multiple tobacco related services and practices.

Over two-thirds of substance use treatment facilities have a 100% tobacco-free policy!

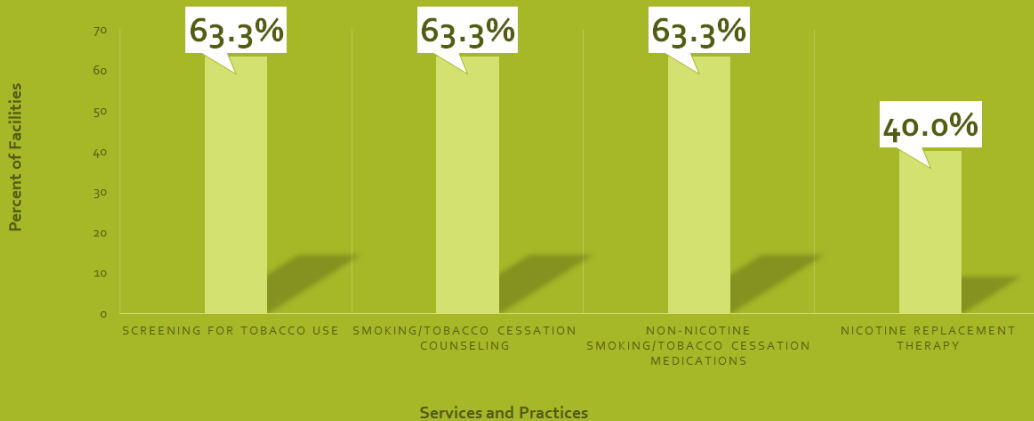
MENTAL HEALTH POLICY, SCREENING AND TREATMENT FACILITIES IN HAWAII

Of the 180 behavioral health treatment facilities in Hawai'i, **30 (16.7%)** are **mental health treatment facilities**.



Mental health treatment facilities are those with licensure/accreditation/approval to provide mental health treatment or services.

WHICH OF THESE SERVICES AND PRACTICES ARE OFFERED AT MENTAL HEALTH TREATMENT FACILITIES (N=30)?



Most mental health treatment facilities provide screening for tobacco use (63.3%).

Less than half of the mental health treatment facilities offer nicotine replacement therapy (40.0%).

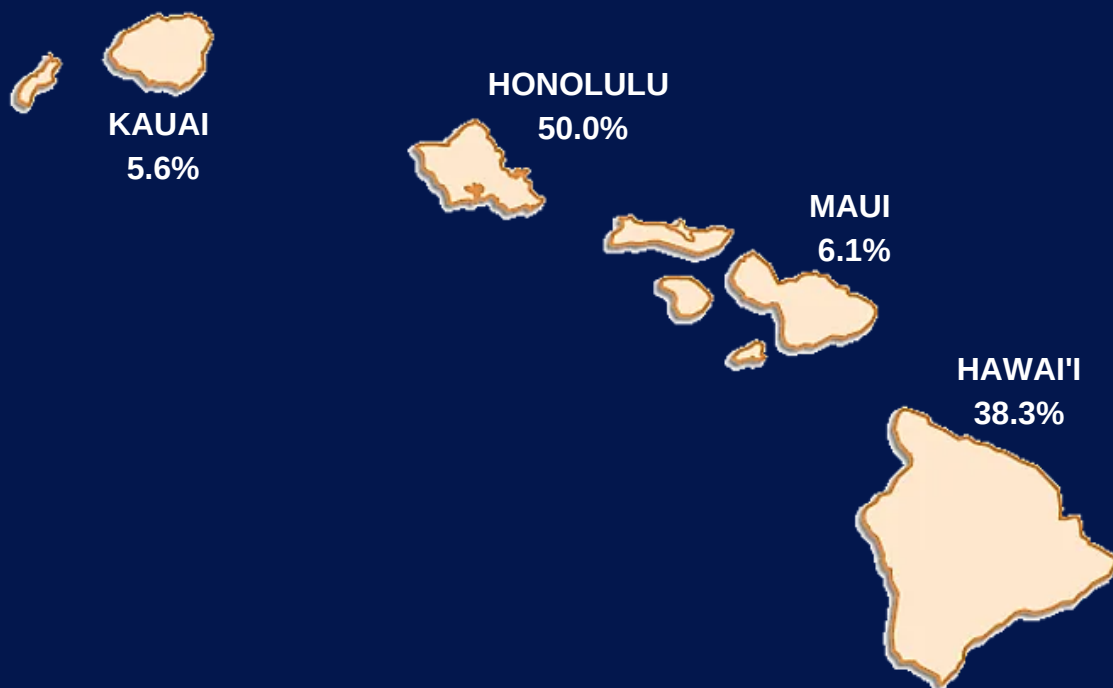
Note: Percentages related to services and practices offered at Mental Health treatment facilities will not total 100% as each facility may offer multiple tobacco related services and practices.

Almost 60% of mental health treatment facilities have a 100% tobacco-free policy!

TOBACCO USE TREATMENT AND BEHAVIORAL HEALTH FACILITIES, BY COUNTY

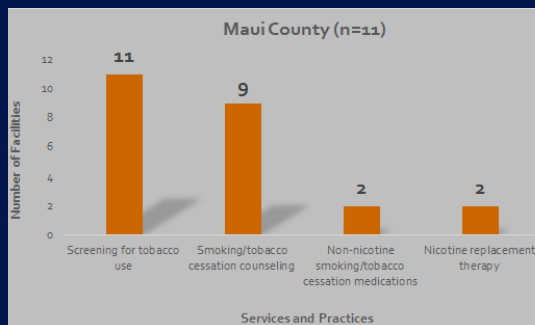
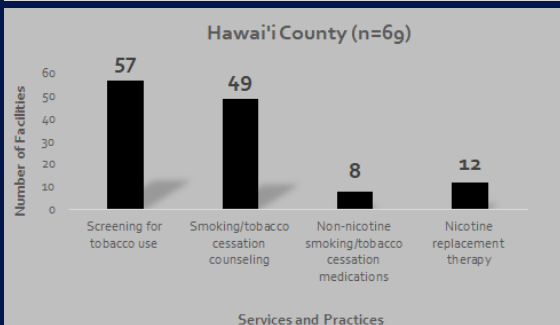
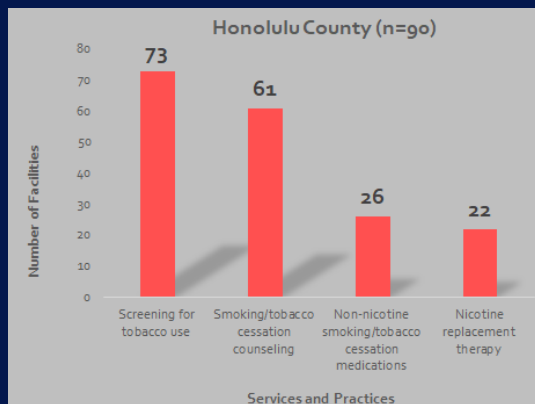
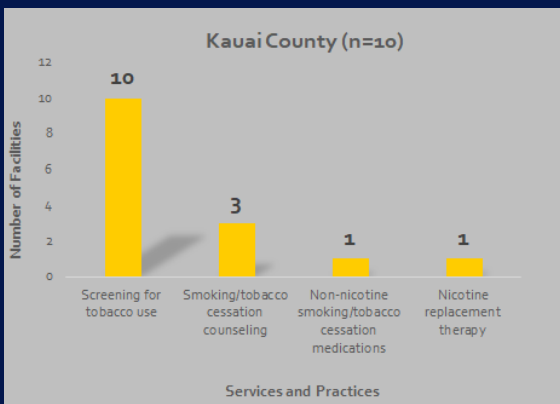


Behavioral Health Treatment Facilities in Hawai'i, by County (N=180)

Key Points

- Most **mental health** and **substance use** treatment facilities are located in Honolulu (50%) and Hawai'i (38.3%) county.
- Most **mental health (63.3%)** and **substance use (88.0%)** offer tobacco use screening.
- The availability of nicotine replacement therapy is higher in **mental health (40%)** compared to **substance use (16.67%)**.
- The availability of cessation medications is much higher in **mental health (63.3%)** compared to **substance use (12.0%)**.
